Statewide / Assistance Programs

1. Ohio Hearing Aid Assistance Program (OHAAP)

- Provides hearing aids and assistive listening devices for children and young adults up to age 21
- Sliding fee scale may apply, services as low as \$20 depending on income

2. Ohio State Health Plan – Hearing Aid Assistance

- For individuals between 200%–400% of the Federal Poverty Level
- Offers financial help with purchase of hearing aids

3. Audiology Patient Assistance (APA) Program – Cleveland Hearing & Speech Center

- Provides hearing aids, assistive listening devices, and repairs for low-income individuals
