1. Ohio Hearing Aid Assistance Program (OHAAP)

- Provides hearing aids, earmolds, and assistive listening devices for children and young adults up to age 21
- Eligibility: permanent hearing loss, income-based
- Application completed by audiologist or hearing aid dealer
